Who can apply and what can you get grants for

The CFR provides grants for research about retailing for researchers and doctoral students at the School of Business, Economics and Law at University of Gothenburg. You can apply for costs for conferences, literature, data collection, language editing, transcribing or other costs connected to research about retailing. Salaries are not covered by the grants.

When to apply

There are four opportunities per year to apply for grants. Last application dates are: 15 January, 15 April, 15 September, 15 November.

The grant is paid from Handelns forskningsstiftelse i Göteborg. All applications are processed by the CFR reference group.

How to apply

Fill out the application form. Only complete applications are processed. Send the signed application in pdf to infoCFR@handels.gu.se.

Notification

The applicant will be notified via e-mail.

Report

The report shall include information about how the grant has been used and what the results were. Report at the latest two months after the grant period is over. Send your report to infoCFR@handels.gu.se.
