Preparations

Biking Vermont starts in Williamstown, Massachusetts. First there will be a short practice ride that focuses on safe riding. After that we will load our bikes with all the things needed for the next two weeks and then we will begin our trip to the Canadian border. Please note that we will not enter Canada, so you do not need your passport.

Tour description

On daily rides (about 25 miles/day), we will bike along green fields, by red barns and past white churches. We will ride through the Lake Champlain Valley, seeking out quiet roads and gentle hills.

Biking along the lake and looking west, we will see the beautiful Adirondack Mountains. To the east are Vermont's Green Mountains with Mount Mansfield, Vermont's highest peak, in the distance.

We will spend a day in Burlington – a nice contrast to the small towns and big farms along our route. You can visit one of the many ice cream shops and down by the lake you can enjoy a big variety of pancakes at a creperie specializing in local products.

Each day brings fun and discovery, and at day's end we will put up our tents at comfortable camping sites.

When we reach the Canadian border, which is the end of the tour, we will celebrate and have a farewell party after our two weeks of fun together. The next day we will return to Williamstown by van.

Who can come?

The *Biking Vermont* tours are for students in grades 7–9. The tours are becoming more and more popular each year, so you must call our office to book.



Fitness

Many teens are first-timers on a bike trip like this. Only few come with any experience. If you are motivated and in good shape, you will keep up just fine. The trip is designed to be a group activity where everyone helps one another.

Challenge level

Biking Vermont is rated 4 on a scale of 1–10 (1 is easiest). The difficulty of the tour is higher than *Cape Cod & the Islands* (Level 2), but it is not as challenging as *New England Coast* (Level 5).

Accommodations

Comfortable tent camping for all nights. Most campgrounds will have flush toilets and showers.
