Teaching experience

I have extensive experience of course development, teaching and examination at both under- and postgraduate level at the Law Degree Programme at the University of Gothenburg.

First cycle education Procedural Law, 15 hec First cycle mandatory course with approx. 200 students annually. As a teacher (2009–2020), I gave lectures and seminars, and participated in examination and marking. As course coordinator (2011–2017), I also reformed the course curriculum, constructed new learning materials (seminars and practice questions), introduced interactive learning activities, and conducted continuous evaluations in dialogue with the student representatives.

Second cycle education

European Law and Procedure, 15 hec Second cycle elective course with approx. 20 students annually. I developed the course curriculum and planned all learning activities and examination. The course was given from 2021 and I was the main teacher 2021–2022. Teaching responsibilities include tutoring (groups of 4-5 students), lectures, and examination.

European Procedural Law I and II, 15 hec each

Second cycle elective courses with approx. 10 students annually. Teaching activities on these courses (2010–2019) included seminars, lectures, feedback and examination. It also includes acting as coach for teams in the European Law Moot Court Competition (ELMC). Teams from this course has reached the ELMC Regional Finals in 2010/11, 2011/12, 2013/14, 2015/16, 2016/17, 2018/19 and the All-European Final 2011/12 (overall second place) and 2015/16 (overall second place). I was the course coordinator 2016–2019.
