

Axel Wolf is a full professor in anaesthesia nursing at the OsloMet University in Oslo, Norway and holds a combined position as Professor and senior consultant nurse anaesthetist at the Sahlgrenska University Hospital and Sahlgrenska Academy at the University of Gothenburg. He is also the vice head for Innovation, Digitalisation and Utilisation at the Institute of Health and Care Sciences, Sahlgrenska Academy, University of Gothenburg, Sweden. Together with collaboration partners from Sahlgrenska University Hospital, Region Västra Götaland, and Industry partners IBM, Astra Zeneca and Doberman, the consortium received initial funding of 3 million SEK during 2012-13 from Vinnova, the Swedish Governmental Agency for Innovation Systems. The project "National Reference Ward for Person-centred Care (NATREF PCV)" aimed to develop the person-centred health care ward of the future and be an open and sustainable testbed for new care forms, services and products such as education, eHealth and IT solutions. NATREF PCV constituted a reference point for the health care of the future, both nationally and internationally through identifying, developing and integrating partial solutions for a change in health care. Outcome: The national reference wards for PCC have reduced their length of hospital stay with 20% and increased patient satisfaction as well as staff engagement level.
