I was born in Rijeka, Croatia, in 1976. I attended International Baccalaureate highschool in Zagreb, and graduated at Faculty of Agriculture in Zagreb in 2004. I did my fourth year of studies at Biotechnical Faculty of Ljubljana, Slovenia, as a part of student exchange program (1999/2000). During studying I participated in several international student workshops (Netherlands, Germany, Slovenia).

During studies, I worked part time to full time for several architects and landscape architects, doing various fields - from gardens to urbanism. After spending several years in Slovenia and after graduation in 2004, I returned to my hometown and started my own landscape architecture company, aimed at doing landscaping projects for residential and touristic objects. My work consisted of designing, as well as project management, as I used to build my projects with a team of contractors, from first sketch till finished space, ready to be used. On a larger

scale, my studio's work consisted of projects for various nature preservation institutions, such as reforestation projects and anti-erosion solutions for paths in areas with high frequency of visitors. In 2010, I received The Young Artist of the year award by Croatian Society of Applied Arts, for my landscape architecture projects.

From 2011. until 2013. I worked as a landscape architect in the office for City Greenery of city of Rijeka.

From 2012 till present I periodically work on Design/Build workshops that Landscape Architecture Department of University of Washington conducts in Croatia. Design/Build program aims to counter primarily classroom educated students by giving them opportunity to design and construct a given space themselves, under the professional guidance.

Design/Build program lead by professor Daniel Winterbottom has one additional goal: creating a therapeutic garden for a community in need. The work conducted usually involves an underprivileged group of people with specific health requirements - such as AIDS patients, war veterans, mental patients and similar - and relies heavily on participatory design. The role of Co-Director of the program, besides the teaching part (in both craft and architecture subjects), usually involves managing the project in terms of budget optimisation and coordination with user groups.

In 2015 I initiated 'Fairytales in Craft' project and invited 9 other artists to collaborate. F.i.C. is a multisensory playscape of craft objects forming a narrative. The project aims to investigate how imaginative storytelling can stimulate making skills in children, and the role of crafts in producing empathy in kids. Through the pilot, we delivered a materialisation of a fairytale inspired by Dalsland nature and history, and through engagement in an immersive environment take children on a journey which ends in making, storytelling, or adventure play. By focusing on imagination and empathy, the project is also critical on contemporary maker-movement being focused primarily on digital fabrication, and through this socially exclusive rather than inclusive. As a designer/maker of furniture, I operate in the field that connects design, craft and cultural background, and I have a rich experience in projects that include collaboration of many actors. I started making comissioned furniture in 2009 and have been running a small craft-devoted gallery from 2010-2012. In 2013 I enrolled at MFA program in Wood Orientated Furniture Design at HDK-Steneby, and graduated in 2015. My work was exhibited at exhibitions and design fairs in Göteborg, Helsinki, Milan, Stockholm and Zagreb. I am currently operating my own design/make practice in rural Dalsland, Sweden.

Since September 2017 I have been working as a teacher at HDK-Valand Steneby - Academy of Craft and Design in Dals Långed, Sweden.
